“Whistling Pete” is included in this renowned series of anthologies. It is listed under the theme of Death and Dying and is a true account of a father and his son on the Fourth of July.



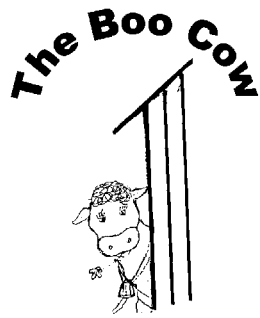
